Course Update

The irrigation system has been repaired and is now 100%. We have been fortunate to have a significant amount of rain in August and have not had to use the system very much. The grass on the course and the greens have held up well through the summer.



Golf Cart Lease

We have paid our last payment on one of our golf cart leases for our rental carts. The club had two groups of carts on lease from Yamaha, and one is now paid off, and we have one that expires next year. The board has decided to purchase the golf carts that were on the lease that just ended, rather than lease more carts. This cost the club \$9000 (\$900 per cart for the ten carts on this lease) and we will now own these carts rather than lease them.

Golf Cart Fundraiser

We have decided to purchase a 2010 Yamaha Gas Golf Cart to use for a fundraiser. We are going to sell 250 tickets at \$50.00 each, and then hold a draw down where we will draw all of the tickets out, with the last ticket drawn being the winner. You can also buy insurance on your ticket for \$10.00. The insurance works like this: If your ticket is drawn out in the first 100 draws, and you bought the insurance, your ticket will be placed back in the pot for a chance to win.
